We are delighted to have you join us for this very important annual event in the life of St. Stephen's in-the-Field Church.

Our objective as a faith community is to provide ever-expanding opportunities for personal growth in faith in God, and for service to others. This calling has led us to powerful ministries both locally and internationally.

One major ministry has been established for the people of the Sudan. We provide funding for the education of the eldest son of the Reverend Mark Atem, Canon to the Bishop of Bor, in southern Sudan. We provide funding to the orphanage that is operated by Peter Nyok, which gives badly needed housing and food for some 39 Sudanese refugees in Kenya. We have helped in locating employment and have provided funding for some of the Sudanese Lost Boys who live in the San Jose area. We periodically host visits by Father Jerry Drino and some of the Sudanese Boys to update us on the work of the Episcopal Church in the Sudan.

We provide support for Santa Maria Urban Ministries, which is located in downtown San Jose, and services the needy and homeless in five zip codes around central San Jose. We provide financial contributions as well as clothing, food, and school supplies. This ministry is owned by the Episcopal Diocese, but only receives partial funding from the Diocese. The Mission heavily relies on other contributions to do the important work that they are committed to providing.

Another new ministry is just beginning. As we continue to grow, we always look outward for new and more effective ways to provide greater value to our south San Jose neighborhood. The decision has been made that we will open a Parish Pre-school this coming September 2<sup>nd</sup>. This pre-school will bring a very important educational and social development resource to the 3 and 4 year old children of our neighborhood. We are very excited about this new ministry, and appreciate the critical support that you provide to us. That support makes this ministry, and all of our ministries possible.

I hope you enjoy this very special day with us. We have worked hard to provide you with a relaxing, fun, entertaining, meaningful day. We hope your drives are straight, and your game is on. We pray that you feel as fulfilled by participating in this day as we feel fulfilled by having you take part in the fun — and in the very important ministries that happen through this annual event.
